book is to shed light on the rather unexplored « English facet » of Fernando Pessoa, considered one of the major Portuguese poets of the twentieth century. The originality of this study also lies in its extensive use of unpublished documents. Out of the bulk of Pessoa's English writings, *The Mad Fiddler* has been selected; it offers not only poems of better quality than most of his writings in English but it also has the advantage of being a complete and coherent suite of « mystical » poems. A systematic comparative study of the themes in *The Mad Fiddler* and in the poems by the four Portuguese heteronyms reveals a clear continuity and shows that Pessoa's bilingual Poetry is based on his main ontological quest, which he tried to solve by means of his dramatic scattering into « masks » . After this comparative analysis, the individuality of *The Mad Fiddler* is defined. Following an overview of the unpublished English writings found in the Pessoaan legacy, *The Mad Fiddler* is analysed by means of Pessoa's own unpublished comments. An investigation of Pessoa's private French library and of his unpublished Literary Appreciations proves how fully he understood the impact of Symbolism on the evolution of Modern Art. *The Mad Fiddler* could indeed be viewed as an English echo of Pessoa's interest in modern trends in Literature and as a kind of « English microcosm » of Pessoa's aesthetic theory.

Der vorliegende Band konzentriert sich daher auf Autoren der frühen Renaissance von Petrarca bis um ca. 1530, wobei weniger die historisch-biographische Rekonstruktion individueller Schicksale im Vordergrund stehen soll, sondern die literarische Vorstellungswelt und die verschiedenen Formen, in denen Exil und Heimatferne im Spannungsfeld zwischen Realität, Selbstfashioning und antiker Tradition thematisiert wurden. Vom 19. bis 21. Juni 2008 fand an der Universität Innsbruck erstmalig eine Tagung statt, die ausschließlich dem epischen Dichter Silius Italicus gewidmet war. Die einzelnen Beiträge, die in diesem Band versammelt und um einige vermehrt wurden, fassen einerseits die bisherigen Forschungen zu zentralen Fragen zusammen, skizzieren andererseits auch neue Wege und Sichtweisen auf einen Dichter, den die Klassische Philologie lange Zeit recht stiefmütterlich behandelt hat. Der Loskauf von Sklaven und Gefangenen hat den Mittelmeerraum von der Antike bis in die Frühe Neuzeit geprägt. Er stellt, eng verbunden mit der Geschichte der Sklaverei, nicht nur verschiedene Facetten des Bemühens um deren Beseitigung dar, sondern ist darüber hinaus auch selbst ein entscheidender Bestandteil verschiedener Konflikt- und Beziehungsgeschichten. Die vierzehn Beiträge dieses Sammelbandes, die auf eine von der DFG geförderte internationale Tagung im September 2013 in Paderborn zurückgehen, betrachten die Thematik erstmalig unter der vorrangigen Fragestellung nach der Bedeutung von Religion. Sie untersuchen epochenübergreifend und aus jüdischer, christlicher und muslimischer Sicht Praxis und Begründungen des Loskaufs aus

den Händeln der jeweils Andersgläubigen. Dadurch werden zum einen die in den drei abrahamitischen Religionen jeweils geführten theologiegeschichtlichen Diskurse analysiert und nach Möglichkeit miteinander in Beziehung gesetzt. Zum anderen gelingt es, die bislang dominierende wirtschafts- und sozialgeschichtliche Betrachtungsweise des Loskaufs um die religionsgeschichtliche Perspektive zu ergänzen und damit ein neues, vielversprechendes Forschungsfeld zu präsentieren. Slave redemption and prisoner redemption characterised the Mediterranean region from antiquity to the early modern age. Closely connected with the history of slavery, these phenomena not only represent different facets of the efforts to end slavery but are also in themselves a decisive part of various histories of conflict and relationships. The fourteen essays in this volume, originally presented at an international conference in Paderborn sponsored by the DFG in September 2013, examine the theme for the first time in terms of the fundamental question of the significance of religion. Taking a broad chronological sweep they examine, from Jewish, Christian and Muslim perspectives, the practice and justification of redeeming slaves from the hands of those of other faiths. Thus the theological and historical discourses in each of the three Abrahamic religions are analysed and the links between them established where possible. The approach also adds the perspective of religious history to the previously dominant social and economic approaches to slave redemption, opening up a new and greatly promising field of research. RD-Position stehen? Und welche pragmatischen Funktionen erfüllen sie dann? Zur Beantwortung solcher Fragen widmet sich die vorliegende Studie der detaillierten Untersuchung gesprochener Sprache bzw. geschriebener Texte, die typische Charakteristika gesprochener Sprache aufweisen. Anhand zahlreicher Beispiele aus dem *italiano parlato* werden pragmatische Funktionen von LD und RD deutlich gemacht.
